**1. Purpose**

One of the priorities of the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust is promoting successful careers for women and girls in the science and technology fields. This annual Prize recognizes the top woman student completing the third year of any Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) programme offered by the University of Waikato. The funding is provided by the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust.

**2. Prize**

\$1,000 and a certificate. The funds will transferred to the recipient's nominated bank account and the certificate is normally presented to the recipient at the Trust's annual awards ceremony.

**3. Closing date**

1 February

**4. Eligibility criteria**

- a. the recipient can be a domestic or international student;
- b. the most outstanding woman student completing the third year of any BE(Hons) programmes offered at the University of Waikato.

**5. Selection**

- a. the recipient will be selected by the Head of the Engineering or their nominee. If there are no candidates of acceptable standard, no prize will be awarded;
- b. the name of the recipient must be forwarded to the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust Awards Committee by email to or posted to PO Box 148, Hamilton 3240 on or before 1 February, annually.
