1. Purpose

To support women enrolled full or part-time in the final year of the following Toi Ohomai Te Pūkenga programme at the Tauranga and Rotorua campuses:

2. Prize

\$1,000. The funds will be transferred to the recipient's nominated bank account . The certificate is normally presented to the recipient at the Trust's annual awards ceremony.

3. Closing date

1 February.

4. Eligibility criteria

The recipients must be women, who at the time:

- a. are enrolled in their first bachelor qualification;
- b. have completed the second year of their programme and are entering, or have enrolled, in the third year of one of the qualifications listed above;
- c. are considered the most outstanding woman student in the programme, based on academic merit and/or demonstrated commitment to study;
- d. are a New Zealand citizen or have been a permanent resident for at least two years.

5. Selection process

The Centre Director/Head of School/Programme Co-ordinator/Team Manager of the qualifications listed above will:

- a. select one recipient from the Rotorua campus and one from the Tauranga campus, based on academic merit and/or commitment to study. If there is no suitable recipient(s) in the programme, no prize will be awarded;
