Wintec Te Pūkenga Undergraduate Prizes - Information

1. Purpose

To support a woman enrolled in their final year of the following Waikato Institute of Technology programmes:

- Bachelor of Teaching (ECE)
- Bachelor of Midwifery
- Bachelor of Engineering Technology

2. Prize

\$1,000. The funds will be transferred to the recipient's nominated bank account. A certificate is normally presented to the recipient at the appropriate Wintec Te Pūkenga awards ceremony.

3. Closing date

1 February.

4. Eligibility criteria

The recipients must be women, who at the time:

- a. are enrolled full or part-time in their first bachelor qualification;
- b. have completed the second year of their programme and are entering, or have enrolled, in the third year of the bachelor qualifications listed above;
- c. are considered the most outstanding woman student in the programme, based on academic merit and/or demonstrated commitment to study;
- d. are a New Zealand citizen or have been a permanent resident for at least two years.

5. Selection process

The Centre Director/Head of School/Programme Co-ordinator/Team Manager or delegate of the programmes listed above will:

- a. select one recipient, based on academic merit and/or commitment to study, from each of the programmes listed above. If, in their opinion, there is no suitable candidate, no prize will be awarded;
- b. submit the names of the recipients to the Waikato Graduate Women Awards Committee by email to awards@wgweducationaltrust.nz by the closing date;
- c. the recipients must indicate whether they are willing to have their name listed on the Waikato Graduate Women Awards webpage.
