University of Waikato Masters Study Award - Information

1. Purpose

To assist women students enrolled in a University of Waikato research masters qualification of at last 120 points with a research thesis of at least 90 points.

2. Funding available

\$2,200 per award. The funds will be transferred to the recipient's nominated bank account. Recipients enrolled part-time will receive their award in instalments. A certificate will be presented to the recipient at the Trust's annual awards ceremony.

3. Closing date

30 April.

4. Eligibility criteria

Applicants must be women who, at the time of applying, are:

- a. enrolled full- or part-time and doing their thesis paper, which must be worth at least 90 points;
- b. a New Zealand citizen, or have held permanent residence for at least two years.

5. Application process

Applications are made online via a link on the <u>Awards</u> page and must be received by the closing date.

6. Selection

- a. The Awards Committee of the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust will administer the Award;
- b. The award is primarily made on academic merit;
- c. The number of awards is subject to availability of funds and the standard of applications. If, in the opinion of the Committee, applications are not of an acceptable standard, no award will be made;
- d. The Committee's decision is final.

7. Awarding

Award winners will be informed in June of the year the application is submitted.
